Please note that local transport tickets are not included in the package prices.

Deposit

A non-refundable deposit of GBP 200 is required to secure an individual student booking. This will be deducted from the total package price. Students staying in a residential accommodation will need to pay a refundable key/damage deposit.

Arrivals/Departures

Students should arrive for their program on the Sunday, where the academic element of the program begins on the Monday, unless otherwise advised. Accommodation is booked from the Sunday (being the program commencement date) until the Saturday after the academic element of the program has ended.

Airport transfers

No airport transfers are included in the individual student package price. Please consult our transfers pricelist for the shared transfer price from London Heathrow or private taxi and small group prices for all airports. Students must notify their Kaplan representative of their flight arrival and departure times in advance so that the transfer can be arranged. The London Heathrow shared transfer service in the UK is offered between 0700 and 1800 on Sunday and departure service is offered for leaving between 1100 and 2200 at London Heathrow on Saturday (please check Parents Handbook for further information on flight restriction times or talk to your Kaplan representative).

Unaccompanied Minors service

If a student is travelling as an unaccompanied minor or hostess-assisted passenger, Kaplan must be informed in advance and full details of the student's arrival and departure provided. An additional charge will apply.

Travel and Medical Insurance

All participants on Kaplan programs are required to have in place, for the duration of their stay, appropriate travel and medical insurance, and evidence of this provision may be required prior to starting the program. Such insurance is available from your Kaplan representative. NB for visitors to the UK or Ireland centers, holding an E-111 certificate is not accepted as adequate provision of such insurance.
