

EC Brighton: St.James' Place - Economy Student House

DESCRIPTION OF LOCAL AREA

St James Place is a 17 minute walk from the city centre or a 13 minute journey using public transport.

The residence is situated in a beautiful four storey house in a quiet lane just off one of Brighton's most vibrant streets - St. James' Street. St. James' Street has a wide range of bars, restaurants and clubs. The residence is also just a few metres away from the Old Steine, where you will find the famous Royal Pavilion.

DESCRIPTION OF ACCOMMODATION

This residence accommodates 11 mixed gender students and is ideal for those who want to live in the centre of Brighton. The rooms are large and well decorated. The residence includes two lounge areas, a dining area, a kitchen and a spacious TV lounge area. The fully fitted kitchen includes a microwave, dishwasher, washing machine and a dryer. The house also has 4 bathrooms which include shower facilities and a cloakroom with a basin. All bedrooms have a wardrobe and desks for study. Bed linen is provided and is changed on a weekly basis.
