## **Information about finding work in the UK and Malta**

### **Who is allowed to work?**

To work in the UK/Malta you must be:

- - A British/Maltese Citizen
- - An EEA citizen
- - A Swiss national

*EEA countries are:*

Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden and the UK.

If you are from another country you will need a work permit before you can work in the UK/Malta.

### **Where are jobs advertised?**

1. a. Local papers often carry adverts for jobs in the 'classified ads'.
2. b. Job agencies: To find local agencies near the school ask at reception or search online.
3. c. Job Centres: These are government-run centres which help people find work.
