Arundel Castle — Built at the end of the 11th Century, this great castle is situated on a hilltop in West Sussex in magnificent grounds.

Brighton City Centre — This trip includes a walking tour of the cosmopolitan city from the beach, to the Royal Pavilion and the quaint cobbled streets known as the Lanes. There is also time to explore the famous Victorian Pier.

Brighton Royal Pavilion — The spectacular oriental palace of the Prince Regent (George IV) is one of the most dazzling and exotic buildings in the British Isles.

Brighton Sealife Centre — Sea Life Brighton is the world's oldest operating aquarium, with 140 years of marine discovery. There are more than 150 creatures to see including sharks, seahorses, turtles and rays.

Brighton Shopping — Brighton is famed for its extensive range of shops. From the big-name stores in the Churchill Square shopping Mall to the quirky boutiques and specialist shops in the Lanes, there's something for everyone!

Cuckmere haven — The dramatic white cliffs at Beachy Head are the highest chalk seas cliffs in the UK. This walk takes you down to the beach where there are spectacular views of the 'Seven Sisters' and some rook pools to explore. Please wear walking shoes!

Eastbourne — Known as one of the sunniest places in Great Britain this trip to Eastbourne encompasses the beach, pier and plenty of shopping

Field Games or Arts & Crafts — A selection of sporting activities on offer such as volleyball, rounders or football. Arts and Crafts example activities include t-shirt design, glass painting or jewellery making

Hever Castle — Hever Castle is an enchanting double-moated 13th Century castle, once the home of Anne Boleyn one of England most famous Queens.

Herstmonceux Castle - Spectacular hands-on science and discovery among the domes and telescopes of a world famous astronomical observatory. Located in the beautiful grounds of Herstmonceux Castle.

London Eye & Covent Garden — Experience a 30 minute ride on the London Eye, with stunning 360° panoramic views across the city. Then a short walk takes you to Covent Garden famous for its shops, street performers, restaurants and theatres.

London, Madame Tussauds — Visit the world famous museum of wax figures and have your picture taken with Prince William, David Beckham or even Captain Jack Sparrow.

London River Cruise & Sightseeing — This full day tour starts at Greenwich Park, with views across London and the Millennium Dome. A cruise on the River Thames takes you under London Bridge and past many sights including the Tower of London. Finally you will be taken on a walking tour past Big Ben, Westminster Abbey and Buckingham Palace, ending up in Trafalgar square for some souvenir shopping.

Oxford — This full-day visit takes you on a walking tour of 'The City of Dreaming Spires'.

Salisbury and Stonehenge – Visit Salisbury's historic site of Stonehenge and discover how the monumental stones travelled the length of the country to make it to where they are now.

Thorpe Park — Visit the nations Thrill Capital with over 30 extreme rides and attractions.

Tower of London and River Cruise - Visit one of London's most iconic landmark, the Tower of London. Despite its grim reputation as a place of torture and death, within these walls you will also discover the history of a royal palace, an armoury and a powerful fortress. A short cruise on the River Thames will then take you under London Bridge and past many of the main sights such as the London Eye and Big Ben, with a bit of free time for souvenir shopping.
