Oxford Street – Oxford Street is famous for its shopping, with over 300 shops and big department stores you can shop till you drop!

Sports in the Park – Visit the famous Regents Park for a game of football, rounders or badminton.

British Museum – The British Museum houses a vast collection of world art and artefacts. This tour allows two hours of exploration into the depths of human history.

Camden Market – For the alternative shopping experience! Also known as the creative heart of London, Camden market is filled with amazing, one of a kind shops and stalls.

Oxford – This full-day visit takes you on a walking tour of 'The City of Dreaming Spires'.

Thorpe Park – Visit the nations Thrill Capital with over 30 extreme rides and attractions.

London, Madame Tussauds – Visit the world famous museum of wax figures and have your picture taken with Prince William, David Beckham or even Captain Jack Sparrow.

Natural History Museum – World-class collections of exhibitions and collections from the natural world, past and present.

Westfield Shopping Centre – Westfield Stratford City is the largest urban shopping and leisure destination in Europe, offering plenty of high street favourites as well as the latest catwalk fashions.

Covent Garden – Covent Garden is famous for its shops, street performers, restaurants and theatres and is visited by more than 30 million tourists each year.

Salisbury & Stonehenge – Visit Salisbury's historic site of Stonehenge and discover how the monumental stones travelled the length of the country to make it to where they are now.

River Cruise & Greenwich – This cruise on the Thames takes you past many famous sights including the London Eye, the houses of Parliament and the Tower of London. Stopping off in Greenwich, a World Heritage site and home to Greenwich Mean Time. **Science Museum** – The Science Museum is world renowned for its historic collections, awe-inspiring galleries and inspirational exhibitions. The 2-hour tour also includes a visit to the Launchpad with over 50 interactive exhibits, plus electrifying shows and lively demos.
